

White Cloud Mountain Minnow (Tanichthys Albonubes)

Distribution: White Cloud Mountain, China/Vietnam border

Water temperature: 15-24 degrees Celsius

Max size: 1-1.5 inches

Ideal tank size: 60 litres and above

A very adaptable fish that can deal with a range of temperatures and water conditions in the wild and the home aquarium. Colourful, active and great in a large shoal.

This species may soon be extinct in the natural habitat, this is unfortunately due to pollution and tourism.



A minimum group size of 4-6 should be kept but given adequate space a group of 40-50 would look great. Ideally should be kept with small and equally peaceful tankmates.

Some hiding spots and floating plants will help keep this species happy.

A variety of small dried, flake and frozen foods (daphnia, cyclops, brineshrimp) are readily accepted.
