

Albino Cory (Albino Corydoras Paleatus)

Distribution: Amazon, South America

Water temperature: 22-26 degrees Celsius

Max size: 2-3 inches

Ideal tank size: 80 litres and above

They are a social fish and the bigger the group the better, minimum group size of 4-6.

As they occupy the bottom area of the tank it is important to have a fine gravel or sand substrate to protect their delicate barbels (whiskers).



I have five in my community aquarium and they are very good at scavenging food and provide good movement in the lower areas of the tank.

They eat tropical flake, sinking pellets, brineshrimp and bloodworm. They also enjoy grazing on algae growing on plants and bogwood.
