

Rummy-nose Tetra (Hemigrammus Bleheri)

Distribution: South America

Water temperature: 23-27 degrees Celsius

Max size: 1.5 inches

Ideal tank size: 90 litres and above

A very colourful and peaceful shoaling fish that should be kept in a minimum group size of 6. As with most shoaling species the larger the group is the better the overall affect will be. When spooked/stressed the red nose will fade out, but the colour returns quickly.



They occupy the middle level of the tank and will get on with many other similarly sized community fish. A mixture of hiding places, dense planting and open swimming areas will bring out the best qualities of this fish.

They eat flake food and small frozen/live foods, such as brineshrimp.
